Whereas, The Student Association understands the importance of maintaining open communication lines between faculty and students

Whereas, undergraduate students have a variety of perspectives that would serve as excellent resources for undergraduate departments

Whereas, Rice Student Vision for the Second Century, led by the Student Association during the 2014-2015 academic school year, supports said collaborative ventures

Resolved, The Undergraduate Advisory Board Task Force shall be created with the charterer of looking to create long-term spaces of communication between students and faculty members within their respective departments.

Resolved, the Undergraduate Department Advisory Board Task Force shall be chaired by two undergraduates chosen by the Student Association President.

Resolved, the Undergraduate Department Advisory Board Task Force shall gather opinion from faculty department chairs, the University Provost, and the undergraduate student body.

Resolved, the Undergraduate Department Advisory Board Task Force shall submit additional legislation cementing these efforts by the end of the 2015 calendar year.

Resolved, the Undergraduate Department Advisory Board Task Force shall be dissolved by the end of the 2015-2016 SA term.
